**IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION**

In accordance with New York State Correction Law Article 6-C, Sex Offender Registration Act, the Southampton Town Police Department has notified us that a Moderate Risk Level 2 registered sex offender is now residing in the community. Please be advised that the exact street address for a Level 2 sex offender is not provided to the school district or to the public in accordance with the law.

The information provided to us by the police is available to you upon request. You may obtain the information from the elementary, middle or high school main offices. This information must be picked up in person. You will be asked to provide your name and address and to provide some means of identification. This is to ensure that the school district takes the utmost care in providing information only to parties with vested interest. Please also be aware that according to New York State Law, "it is illegal to use this information to commit a crime against the above listed person or to engage in illegal discrimination or harassment against this person."

In the past, I suggested that all families should register with Parents for Megan's Law for their email alert program which will, at no cost, generate emails to participating members with additional information about any sex offender living in our community. Let me again encourage our school community members to register for this email alert program.
