*If you are unable to make the trip @ the last minute, you must contact Karen Owens @ 315.430.0446 by 9AM the day before the trip in order to obtain a refund. No refunds for no shows, if you snooze you lose...*

1. Due to insurance liability, all participants MUST be a WHB PTO member (forms can be found in the main office of HS & MS or on WHBSD website)
2. Please write checks payable to Snowbirds Ski Tours (no cash please)
3. Please complete ALL information on cover form, including alternate phone #s
4. All students MUST have the medical waiver signed off by a parent/guardian
5. If renting ANY equipment a rental equipment form must be completed. Equipment rental is \$35.00, helmet rental is a separate fee of \$10.00
6. Chaperones are required on all trips. If a parent or teacher is willing to chaperone, please fill out a SEPARATE cover form as a chaperone, with a SEPARATE check for the applicable amount. If you are needed as a chaperone, your check will be returned to you. Chaperones are chosen on a first come/first serve basis and by the needs of the trip. Please be aware that chaperones have RESPONSIBILITIES during the day @ the mountain, in the event of a medical emergency, as well as on the bus.
7. If there is space available on the bus, parents/guardians/alumni are always welcome to join the trip.
8. We suggest students bring snacks, change of clothes, and label belongings.
9. Arrive at HS parking lot by 3:40, the bus leaves from the HS parking lot @ 4AM, we CANNOT wait for anyone.
10. Please submit your forms ASAP to ensure space on the bus.
11. Completed forms include; signed permission slip on cover form, medical waiver release, enclosed check, and Okemo equipment rental form (if applicable)

### **Waiver/Acceptance of Responsibility - Release**

Alpine skiing & snowboarding are challenging & dangerous recreational activities. Be alert to continually changing weather, visibility, surface conditions, & terrain features. Snow, ice, moguls, jumps, snowmaking mounds, shear drop-offs, bare ground, rocks, roots, stumps, trees, lift towers, bumps, snowmaking equipment, grooming vehicles, snowmobiles, other skiers & snowboarders, power poles & other natural or man-made objects are inherent risks of the sport. Falls or collisions with natural or man-made obstacles can cause permanent catastrophic injury or death, or property damage. Your safety is directly affected by your judgment. Failure to use good judgment while skiing and/or snowboarding may result in the loss of trip privileges. Skiing & snowboarding can be enjoyed in many ways. Regardless of how you decide to enjoy the slopes, always show courtesy to others & be aware that there are elements of risk in the sport that common sense & personal awareness can help reduce.

#### **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE**

1. Never ski in any area not designated for skiing.
2. Never ski beyond your limits or ability to overcome variations in slope, trail configuration and surface or subsurface conditions, which may be caused or altered by weather, slope or trail maintenance work by the ski area operator, or skier use.
3. Always follow the directions of the ski area operator.
4. Always stay in constant control of speed and course so you can avoid colliding with obstacles or other skiers.
5. Throughout the ski day, familiarize yourself with posted information before skiing any slope or trail.
6. Never cross the uphill track of any surface lift, except at points clearly designated by the ski area.
7. Never ski on any part of a slope or trail which has been designated as "closed" by the ski area.
8. Never leave the scene of any accident resulting in personal injury to another skier until such time as a representative of the ski area operator arrives, except for the purpose of summoning aid, and then identify yourself.
9. Never overtake another skier in a way that you might strike the skier being overtaken and always yield the right-of-way to the skier being overtaken.
10. Do not stop on any slope or trail where you might cause a collision with other skiers or vehicles.
11. Always yield to other skiers when entering a trail or starting downhill.
12. Always wear retention straps or other devices to prevent runaway skis or snowboards.
13. Report any personal injury to the ski area operator's office before leaving the ski area.
14. Never remove, deface, alter or damage signs or warning devices for your safety and the safety of other skiers.

Snowbirds Ski Tours acts solely as an agent between the client and the mountain and cannot be held liable for any injury, loss, and/or damage sustained during any ski trip. In addition, the parents/guardians of all minor students and/or all others who participate are fully aware of the risks involved in this sport therefore cannot hold the Westhampton Beach PTSO, including all board members, and the Westhampton Beach School District liable for any injury, loss, and/or damage sustained during this ski/snowboard trip. Skiing can be a wonderful experience. Snowbirds Tours and Westhampton Beach PTSO stress that all participants put safety and respect for the mountain first and foremost. These trips are for the enjoyment of all people who book them; therefore Snowbirds Tours also reserves the right to ban from future trips anyone whose behavior is considered unsatisfactory.
