EXTERNAL AUDIT REPORT

Ms. Marianne VanDuyne of R.S. Abrams reviewed the District's annual external audit report. Ms. VanDuyne once again stated that no material weaknesses were found, and that the District is in good financial health.

EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION

Dr. Herr recognized this year's National Merit Scholarship Commended Students: Ali Jedlicka, Joseph Litjens, James Daniels, Josephine Perl, Andre Insalaco, and Madison Quinn; as well as National Merit Scholarship Semi-Finalist Gavin Ehlers. Ms. Mensch presented achievement awards to the students.

Dr. Herr and Golden Canes Club students Sydney Anastasia and Kaitlyn McDermott gave a presentation on their fundraising efforts to support children with cancer. They have raised \$10,000 to date.

Dr. Herr and Dr. Finn reviewed some possible course book additions/changes in regards to AP Human Geography, Intro to Science Research, Advanced Science Research, and Geometry.

EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION

Dr. Probst reviewed the history of the American Rescue Plan Bill, the assurances that are part of the grant application, the plans for the grant money, as well as the status of the District's application.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Several community members addressed the Board regarding their concerns about the assurances in the ARP Grant. Specifically, community members spoke about assurance 4 and concerns for student data and privacy, assurance 17 and concerns regarding COVID-19 vaccine mandates, and assurance 20 and potential federal involvement in curriculum.

Dr. Probst and the Board shared that all assurances had been reviewed by District counsel and administration. The assurances were found to be in standard form and comparable to those associated with other grants for which the District applies and accepts funds. Further, Dr. Probst, the Board, and counsel do not interpret the assurances, particularly assurances 4, 17, and 20, in the manner presented by some community members. The Board confirmed its intention to stand behind those interpretations in the future, if needed.

Community members also spoke about Critical Race Theory, the Equity Committee, and communication with the community.
